Street Lights

South Central Power has completed an audit of all street lights in the village. This audit has confirmed the lights the village is paying for and the lights that are property owner pay. The village provides more than 120 street lights throughout the village.

REMINDER: No open burning in the village.

Water Bills

All water/sewer payments are due by the 10th of the month. Even if you are on a payment plan, your payment is due on the 10th.

If you are moving you must contact the office to schedule a shut off and meter reading. If this is not done you will continue to be responsible for that water bill.
